**BAMBOO CUTTING BOARD
AND ACCESSORY**

USE AND CARE INSTRUCTIONS:

Your cutting board was manufactured from **BAMBOO**, an extremely strong natural material that resists damage when cutting. Unlike hardwoods, Bamboo is a type of grass which is a renewable resource. It is harder and lighter than Maple and has a natural beautiful finish.

FEET INSTALLATION: Before you can use the cutting board the feet must be installed.

- Remove the four feet and screws from the packing.
- Place the feet in the cutouts on the underside of the board and tighten the screws enough so that the feet can be turned.
- Place and position the cutting board on the sink.
- Turn the feet so that they hold the board in desired position.
- Turn the board over and tighten the screws, to lock the feet in position.

Please Note: Overtightening the screws will break the feet.

To keep your cutting board and accessory looking new, please follow these use and care instructions.

| DO NOT... | Place your bamboo cutting board in a dishwasher. |
| DO NOT... | Use scouring pads, abrasive cleansers, harsh detergents, vinyl solvents, or substances containing aromatic hydrocarbons or ketones to clean your board and accessories. |
| DO NOT... | Place hot cooking utensils on your accessories. |
| DO... | Avoid prolonged contact with foods such as berries and coffee grounds, as they may stain the board and accessories. After use wash with warm soapy water, rinse and wipe dry immediately with a clean cloth. |
| DO... | Store your cutting board in a cool dry area. Avoid exposure to excessive heat or extreme dampness. Excessive dryness or humidity can cause cracking. |
| DO... | Apply Food Grade Mineral Oil regularly to prevent the wood from drying out. To restore the surface use fine sandpaper and apply mineral oil. |

Please Note:- Using bleach to sanitize your cutting board may change the appearance.

AMERICAN-STANDARD ONE-YEAR LIMITED WARRANTY

If inspection of this American-Standard plumbing product, within one year after its initial installation, confirms that it is defective in materials or workmanship, American-Standard will repair or, at its option, exchange the product for a similar model.

This warranty **does not apply** to local building code compliance. Since local building codes vary considerably, the purchaser of this product should check with a local building or plumbing contractor to insure local code compliance before installation.

This warranty **shall be void** if the product has been moved from its initial place of installation; if it has been subjected to faulty maintenance, abuse, misuse, accident or other damage; if it was not installed in accordance with American-Standard's instructions; or if it has been modified in a manner inconsistent with the product as shipped by American-Standard.

American-Standard's option to repair or exchange the product under this warranty does not cover any labor or other costs of removal or installation, **nor shall American-Standard be responsible for any other incidental or consequential damages attributable to a product defect or to the repair or exchange of a defective product, all of which are expressly excluded from this warranty.** (Some states or provinces do not allow the exclusion or limitation of implied warranties, so this exclusion may not apply to you.)

This warranty gives you specific legal rights. You may have other statutory rights that vary from state to state or from province to province, in which case this warranty does not affect such statutory rights.
