

5. Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
6. Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable(nickel-cadmium) batteries.
7. Exhausted batteries are to be removed from the toy.
8. Do not burn batteries. Dispose of batteries in a safe and appropriate manner.
9. Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended.
10. Batteries are to be inserted with the correct polarity.
11. The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.

## Changing the Batteries

This toy comes with trial batteries. For best performance, we suggest changing the batteries before using the toy.

1. Loosen the battery compartment using a cross-headed screwdriver (Fig. 1).
2. Remove the cover and insert 2 new AA (1.5v) batteries (Fig. 2, Fig. 3).
3. Replace the cover and tighten the screw firmly (Fig. 4, Fig. 5).

## Storage and Cleaning

1. Make sure the toy is turned off.
2. Remove the batteries for long term storage.
3. Use a damp cloth to wipe clean.
4. Do not immerse in water.

## And Don't Forget These Safety Rules:

1. Batteries should be replaced by adults only.
2. Do not mix old and new batteries.
3. Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged.
4. Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the toy before being charged.
