

# **WARNING**

**Failure to follow these warnings and the assembly instructions could result in serious injury or death.**

- **The crib must be fully assembled and set up before use.**
- **Always provide the supervision necessary for the continued safety of your child. When used for play, NEVER leave child unattended.**
- **Strings can cause Strangulation! DO NOT place items with a string around a child's neck such as hood strings or pacifier cords. DO NOT suspend strings over crib or attach strings to toys.**
- **To reduce the risk of SIDS, pediatricians recommend healthy infants be placed on their back to sleep unless otherwise advised by your physician.**
- **DO NOT place crib near window where cords from blinds or drapes can strangle a child.**
- **DO NOT use crib near objects that a child could reach or pull into crib and cause injury such as lamps, heaters, fireplaces, or ironing boards.**
- **When child is able to pull to a standing position, remove bumper pads, large toys and other objects that could serve as steps for climbing out.**
- **Discontinue use of the crib when child is able to climb out or reaches the height of 35 inches (90 cm). The child should be placed in a youth or regular bed.**
- **DO NOT use a water mattress with this crib.**
- **To avoid injuries, do not allow children to climb or play on or under crib.**

# **!WARNING**

## **Infant can suffocate**

- In gaps between a mattress too small or too thick and side of crib.
- On Soft bedding.  
NEVER add a mattress, pillow, comforter or padding.
- Use only the mattress provided by the manufacturer (which must be at least 38 inches (96.5 cm) long by 24 inches (61 cm) wide and not more than 4 inches (10 cm) thick).
- Never use plastic shipping bags or other plastic film as mattress covers not sold and intended for that purpose. They can cause suffocation.

## **WARNING:**

**ANY MATTRESS USED IN THIS CRIB MUST BE AT LEAST 38 INCHES (96.5 CM) LONG BY 24 INCHES (61 CM) WIDE AND NOT MORE THAN 4 INCHES (10 CM) THICK.**

# **!WARNING**

**Do not use this crib if the enclosed or attached instructions cannot be strictly adhered to. Do not use this crib if the child is able to climb out unaided or is taller than 90 cm. Do not place cords, straps or similar items that could become wound around the child's neck in or near this crib. Ensure that the sides are properly latched or locked in place when the crib is occupied. The mattress used with this crib should not be more than 15 cm thick and should be of such length and width that the gap between the mattress and the sides of the crib is not more than 3 cm when the mattress is pushed into the corner of the crib.**

# CRIB FOLDING INSTRUCTIONS

## ⚠ WARNING

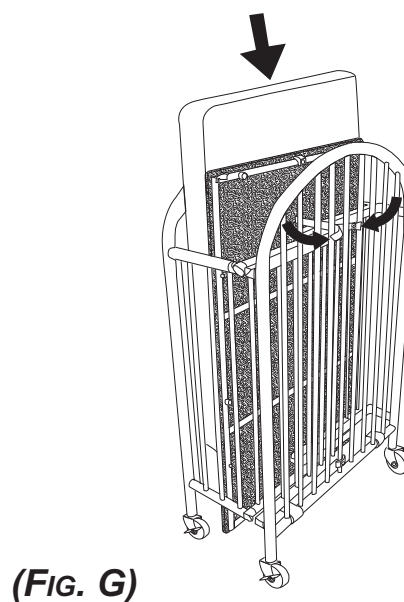
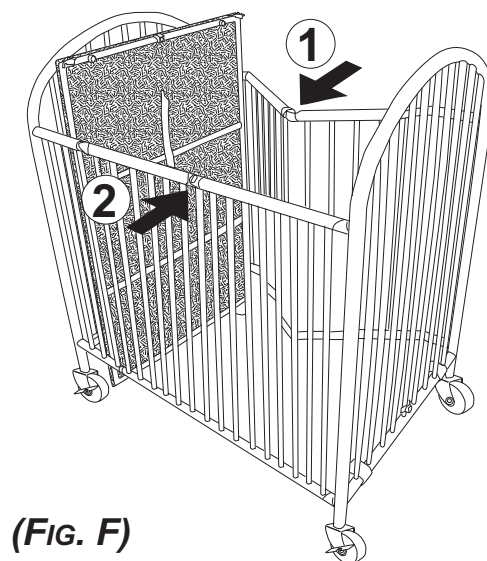
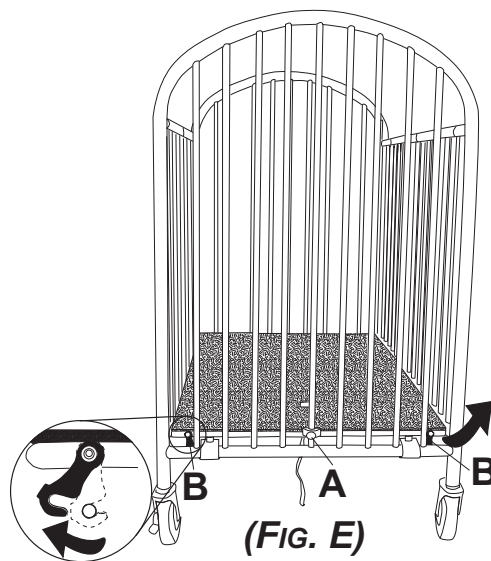
- Avoid injury from pinching, keep fingers away from hinges during assembly, set up, and folding of crib.

1. Remove *Mattress* from crib and set aside.
2. Unlock *Red Mattress Support Latches "B"* (Fig. E).
3. Pull out on *Mattress Support Latch "A"* (Fig. E) and raise *Mattress Support* up into vertical position.
4. While holding *Mattress Support* up, grasp side of crib where hinge is closest to *Mattress Support* and begin folding crib (Fig. F).
5. Fold opposite side of crib inward.
6. Secure closure strap (Fig. G).
7. Place *Mattress* in space between *End Panel* and *Mattress Support* (Fig. G).

This completes folding the crib.

Crib is ready for storage.

Store crib in a cool, dry place.

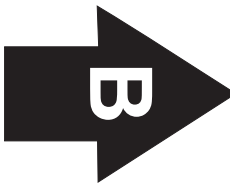


## **MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING**

### **! WARNING**

- Periodically check the safety of your crib for damaged hardware, loose joints, missing parts or sharp edges. **DO NOT** use crib if any parts are missing or broken. **DO NOT** substitute parts.
- Avoid using furniture polish or cleaning agents that may be hazardous to children.
- If refinishing, use only non-toxic finish specified for children's products.

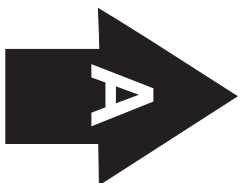
- This crib is guaranteed to meet all federal and state standards and will provide many years of service provided you adhere to the guidelines for assembly, maintenance and operation.

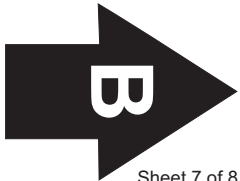

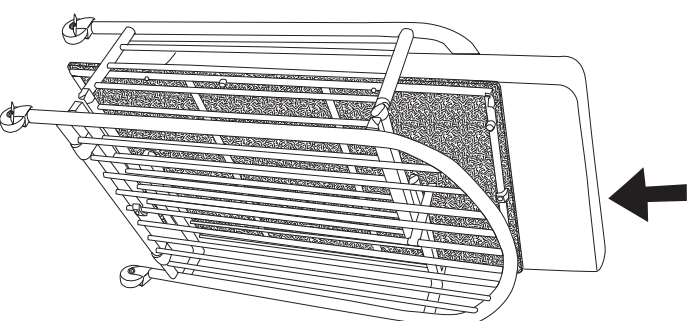
